

Your Ideal Monarda 'Schneewittchen'

"This perennial will bring the buzz to your garden with its bee-friendly flowers.

Appearing on tall stems between late summer and early autumn, the white flowerheads perch above aromatic foliage that is spicy with hints of citrus and mint"

On arrival

Unpack plant immediately upon delivery, carefully lifting them out of the box by its pot to avoid damaging top growth. Place in a cool, light spot outside and give some water if the compost seems dry. Don't worry about planting straight away. This lovely perennial can be left in its container until planting is convenient.

Where to grow

This plant is best in full sun and perfect for planting in beds and borders.

Planting in the ground

As it's fully hardy, this perennial can be planted at any time, as long as the ground isn't frozen or waterlogged. Planting is super easy.

- Dig a round hole that's about twice the diameter of the container and the same depth.
- Place in the centre of the hole and fill gaps with soil, firming down as you go to remove air pockets.
- After planting, the top of the rootball should be level with the surface.

Aftercare

- Water regularly during dry spells.
- Dead head fading flowers to encourage more to form stop dead heading in September to allow seed heads to form and provide sculptural, winter interest.
- Cut back old flowering stems in late winter.
